



Important FACTS that every pregnant mother should know

FACT: Rhesus Haemolytic Disease can cause the death of your baby or result in your baby having serious disabilities such as deafness or cerebral palsy.

BUT – it is entirely preventable!

Rhesus Haemolytic Disease does not usually affect your first baby but can cause the death or disability of your subsequent babies. It is caused if you have one particular type of blood group and if your first baby has a different type.

PREVENTION – It can be prevented by receiving a simple injection immediately after your first baby is born. It can also be prevented by receiving an injection in the later part of your pregnancy.
